- 18.1.3 A student who graduated from high school after May 1, 2003, must apply for the Millennium Scholarship within 6 years of high school graduation in order to be eligible for receipt of scholarship funds. (B/R 6/05)
- 18.1.4 A student who graduated from high school in Spring 2010 and thereafter must successfully complete the core curriculum defined in Section 18.14 to gain eligibility.**

18.14 ~~(section removed)~~ ***The Board recognizes the importance of a rigorous high school curriculum in adequately preparing students to succeed in college-level courses. Therefore, a student who graduates from a Nevada high school in Spring 2010 and thereafter must successfully complete the following curriculum in high school to be eligible for the Millennium Scholarship:***
