An addition to Title 4, Chapter 10, Section 8 (I) spells out clearly that the President shall ensure that a) the regular selection process for filling administrative or faculty positions is followed if a private gift is involved, b) no undue or inappropriate influence by or on behalf of a donor has been exerted, and c) private gifts do not interfere with the normal scholarship and research of the institution.
IMPETUS (WHY NOW?):
The Board wants to ensure that donors and private gifts are handled appropriately and the integrity of the institutional processes is protected.
BULLET POINTS TO SUPPORT REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:
 Similar policies are in place in many higher education institutions across the nation; The President establishes the basis for approval of any gift and these policies provide guidance for the President in making such decisions; and The policies do not discourage private gifts to support NSHE institutions.

Donors should have the prerogative to be directly involved in the operations of the institutions.
