<ul> <li>BULLET POINTS TO SUPPORT REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:</li> <li>The Board of Regents does not have a hate crimes policy.</li> <li>Adopting the proposed policy will require each institution to consider how to handle hate crimes that may be committed on campus.</li> <li>All institutions will adopt policies and procedures regarding the response to and investigation of hate crimes.</li> </ul>	
POTENTIAL ARGUMENTS AGAINST THE REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:     Hate crimes have been extremely rare on NSHE campuses and there is no need for a new policy to address this issue.
