Section 14- Fee Waivers for Active Duty Military

- 1. If approved by the president, institutions may waive special course fees, studentifiedes other mandatory fees except the per credit registration fee for members of the Armed Forces of the United States who are stationed in Nevada or at the Marine Corps Mountain Training Center at Pickle Meadows, California.
- 2. For purposes of this section, "Armed Forces of the United States" means the Army, the Navy, the Air Force, the Marine Corps and the Coast Guard active duty and does not include the National Guard or other reserve force, with the exception of active members of the Nevada National Guard.
