2. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

Existing Board policy includes comprehensive viscons regarding discrimination. In 2015, the Board adopted exter revisions to these provisions recommended by the NSHE Title IX Task Force to comply with the federal Violence Against Women Act. At that time, the lists of acts of unlawful discritionathroughout the Handbookere expanded to include, among other items, discrimination based on "sexual orientation, gender identity or expression."

The 2017 Legislature passed Senate Bill 1286apter 197, Statutes of Neva20217), which revises provisions prohibiting certain discriminatory acts. In particular, Section 22 of S.B. 188 amends NRS 396.530 as follows:

S.B. 188 -Sec. 22396.530 Discrimination in admission prohibited.

The Board of Regents shall not discriminate inadenission of students on account of national origin, religion, agephysical disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity expression race or color.

 In the admission of students, community collegies not discriminate on the basis of a person's age, disability, ethnicity, gender, national origin, race, religion, [or] sexual orientation or gender identity or expression

<u>Section 26. State College Admission – General Policy</u>

1. In the admission of students, the state colleged not discriminate on the basis of a person's age, disability, ethnicity, gender, national origin, race, religion, [or] sexual orientation or gender identity or expression
