# 1. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

- x The evolving complexity of the legal requirements growing college athletics, including Title IX, NCAA and ongoing litigation require special knowledge and expertise which can be developed by the members of a Standing Committee.
- x The Board will also consider in a separate agenda item whether to amend Board policy and Code to delegate the appointment of all head athletic coach and athletic director contracts to the institution president. If that **ostap** is accepted by the Board, the charge of the standing Athletics Committee will need to be amended to delete subsections" *Review head coach and athletic director contracts and recommend to the Board individuals for appointment.*"

- x Athletics issues can be handled by the full Board as needed.
