Millennium Scholarship Core Curriculum

BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

Pursuant to state law (*Nevada Revised Statutes* [NRS] 396.930), the Board of Regents defined a core curriculum that students must take to be eligible for the Millennium Scholarship beginning in Spring 2010. As defined, the Millennium Scholarship Core Curriculum requires 4 years of English, 4 years of mathematics, 3 years of natural science, and 3 years of social
